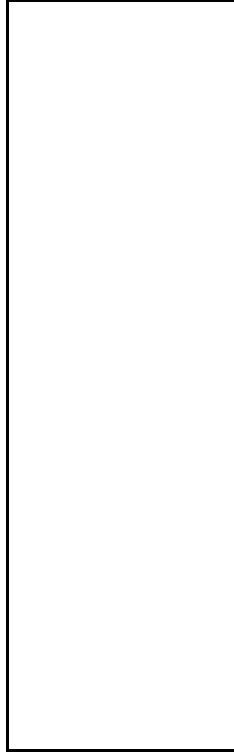

Email confirmations will be sent, but not necessarily immediately upon receipt.

DEL MONTE KENNEL CLUB - RV RESERVED OVERNIGHT PARKING INFORMATION - RESERVE EARLY - 2019

Hours: RV Overnight parking will be available: Thursday, July 11 – 4:00PM – 10:00PM; Friday, July 12 – 6:00 AM – 9:00 AM & 3:00PM – 10:00PM; Saturday, July 13 – 6:00AM – 7:00AM & after BIS – 10:00PM; Sunday, July 14 – 6:00AM – 7:00AM; All vehicles must be off the grounds by 8:00PM Sunday, July 14, 2019. Your parking space will be available in the afternoon of your arrival date, if you arrive earlier, you will pay for an additional night.

COST: \$90 per space for 2 nights. **Two (2) night minimum.** Additional night is \$45. **ONE NIGHT IS NOT AVAILABLE.** Spaces are 22' x 40'. Tagalong vehicles: **\$35.00 flat fee - one, two or three nights,** & must fit in your space, if not, they will be accommodated where possible. There will be no other accommodations for tagalong/tow vehicles in the RV overnight area unless it fits into your space. No vehicle traffic in RV areas during show hours.

No visitors can drive down to the RV area to drop off dogs, people, load, unload and/or visit. You must park in the day of show lot and walk.

Vehicles over 40' total length &/or with slide outs that will not fit in a 22' x 40' space will need to buy 2 spaces. If your entire package will not fit in a 22' x 40' space, you will need to buy additional space. Trailers & tow units may be required to be unhitched. Vehicles over 40' in length will be accommodated where possible. No more than 2 vehicles with a total length of 40' per space, this includes tag/tow vehicles.

NO ELECTRIC HOOK-UPS ARE AVAILABLE ANYWHERE ON THE GROUNDS - PLEASE BE PREPARED THAT YOU WILL NOT HAVE ELECTRICITY

All RV's using a generator must have a proper exhaust pipe venting away from the dogs &/or people – Quiet time: 11:00 PM – 6:00 AM – No generators

RV OVERNIGHT PARKING COULD BE ON ASPHALT, CRUSHED ROCK, DIRT, WEEDS &/OR GRASS, BRING GROUND COVER. THERE IS NO GUARANTEE YOU WILL BE PARKED ON GRASS.

RV Spaces are PRE-ASSIGNED by RV Overnight Parking Coordinator. THOSE WISHING TO PARK TOGETHER MUST SEND THEIR RESERVATIONS TOGETHER, however there is no guarantee that we can accommodate all requests.

Notice To Exhibitors

1. Telephone, Conditional and Unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms or photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries without fees are not acceptable. Fees must accompany entries.
2. Post dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Club will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor(s) may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
3. **PLEASE TYPEWRITE or NEATLY PRINT** all entries. Use black or blue ink. Do not use pencil.
4. **CHANGES, ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS** to entry forms must be received **IN WRITING** prior to close of entries. Changes are not acceptable by telephone. E-mail or faxed changes are allowed.
5. **ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS** — Owners alone are responsible for the correctness of entries, or for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which the dog is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date and time. Due to cost of processing, no refunds less than \$4.00 will be made.
6. **FIRST ENTRY OF EACH DOG IN CONFORMATION OR OBEDIENCE** includes an AKC Recording Fee of \$.50. In addition, each entry of a dog in single-entry recording classes includes \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee. These fees are required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test and are collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, these fees are collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). Each Beginner Puppy entry fee includes a \$2.00 AKC recording fee.
7. **ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED** in event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event's Show Committee. If, because of riots, wars, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, strikes, national emergencies, health emergencies, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.
8. **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRY AND SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME** will be sent to the address on the Official AKC Entry Form after the closing date, as soon as practicable. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show, please notify the Show Secretary.
9. **DECLINATION OF ENTRIES:** The Club may decline any entry for cause, and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
10. **PLEASE NOTE:** Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Sec 6)
11. **DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
12. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club and/or its Show Secretary will not be responsible for, and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.
13. **NO DOGS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE SHOW AREA** except those regularly entered in the show. There will be NO SPACE for unentered dogs at this show. All dogs shall be kept on leash or confined, except when being judged or in the exercising ring.
14. **ALL AWARDS WILL BE MADE** in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the owner or the agent. All claims for trophies must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging, and the Show Secretary should be advised at once of any discrepancy. The show-giving club and its officials disclaim any liability for any awards not claimed on the day of the show.
15. The Club will take every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it is understood that the Monterey Bay Great Dane Club will not be responsible for loss. The welfare of the exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Please secure proper crates or means to confine dogs for the welfare of all concerned.
16. No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.
17. As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Neutered dogs are allowed to compete in the Stud Dog Class. With the increasing number of dogs coming home sick from shows, some with minor illnesses and some with life-threatening and fatal conditions, we urge all exhibitors not to bring sick dogs to the show. Nor should you be bringing un-vaccinated or under-vaccinated dogs to the show. When you sign the Official AKC Entry Form, you are certifying to agree to the rules, regulations and policies of the AKC and of this club. This includes vaccination of your dogs under the supervision of your licensed veterinarian.

Reminder: Unentered Dogs

AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Ch 11, Sec 11

Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under The American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts, except that dog engaged as a special attraction with AKC approval may also be present (e.g., a puppy ENTERED in the 4-6 Mo. Puppy Competition). These dogs shall be subject to all rules relating to health and veterinarians.

The **SHOW PRECINCTS** will be defined as within 6 feet from the Great Dane Conformation Ring. It is the responsibility of the Show Committee and the Show Secretary to enforce the AKC rules. If a puppy is within the show precincts and appears to be less than 6 months old, then either that puppy must be entered in the 4-6 Mo. Puppy Competition, or the owner must provide proof that the dog is 6 months of age or older, and proof of vaccinations or a letter from your veterinarian describing his/her vaccination protocol. If you cannot provide these, then your puppy must be removed from the show precincts. If you fail to comply, then a Bench Show Committee hearing may be called.

Important Notice to Exhibitors & Fanciers

California State policy prohibits the use of alcohol or tobacco products ANYTIME (24/7) or ANYWHERE on school property. Non-compliance may result in an Event Committee hearing.

We must each accept our responsibility for cleaning up after our dogs and leading the way for others to follow. Be prepared to dispose of any trash and/or leavings from your dog(s). Control your dog(s) at all times. **CLEANING UP IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY!** Violators may be reported to the Bench Show Committee for disciplinary action. Have someone in your set-up area at all times.

Please **DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES.** Do not leave your dogs in unlocked cars. If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures where it is confined without supervision a California Humane Officer or a Security Officer will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the Bench Show Committee for disciplinary action.
